

AFRICAN SERENADE CHORAL PROJECT CHOIR PROFILE

Founded in Wesselton, Ermelo in January 2004 and popularly known as African Serenade, the choir has grown from the initial 40 members to its current membership of 60. It prides itself with membership covering Wesselton, Mzinoni, Mbalenhle, Sakhile and Zamokuhle townships. Membership is however not limited to Mpumalanga as it has swelled to Gauteng, Free State as well as KZN.

Regular feature in provincial competitions, the choir is still community entrenched as it offers assistance to local schools with their choral needs and community projects.

Under the guidance of Khabazela, the choir has represented the Mpumalanga province at the NCF nationals in 2009, 2010 and 2015.

2016 Mpumalanga Choral Eisteddfod Champions and 2016 Gacma Silver category runners-up, African Serenade is coming from a successful maiden choral concert held in July 2017.
