The choir is based in the Ga-rankuwa Campus of the Tshwane University of Technology previously known as Setlogelo Technicon.

TUT Ga-rankuwa Campus Choir has participated in various competitions including National Choir Festival (NCF), South African Tertiary Institution of Choral Association (SATICA) and many more. In 2014, the choir was crowned Gauteng Standard Section Champions in the NCF and represented Gauteng at the finals.

In 2017, they participated in the Inter-Campus and were crowned Champions on the Folklore and Cross-over Section and represented the Institution at SATICA, where they achieved the following:

- Position 1 Western
- Position 2 HIV/AIDS
- Position 2 African
- Position 2 (Overall in Indigenous Category)
- Best Dressed Choir
- Overall Champion in the Silver Category



In 2018, we participated in the Tshwane University of Technology (TUT) Inter-Campus Competition and obtained “bragging rights” as the 2018 TUT Inter-Campus Champions with overall score of 88 marks, where they achieved the following:

- Position 1 Isitibili/Crossover/Indigenous



We were also fortunate to participate in the World Choir Games 2018 competition in Tshwane where we obtained a Golden Diploma – Level 1 which qualifies Ga-rankuwa Choir to automatically compete in the Championship Category for the next 5 years.
