Maseru City Chorale is the community Choir in the Capital town of the Mountain Kingdom of Lesotho. Its choristers are students, workers, and unemployed young adults based in ten districts of Lesotho.

It was formed by the workers of Maseru City Council in 1990, and it was named Maseru City Council Chorale. It started participating in different competitions inside and outside Lesotho in 1993 and in 1994 they became the Free State regional champions of the National Choir Festival. It later changed its name to Maseru City Chorale to accommodate the whole community. It has been consistently performing in different festivals and competitions in the Southern Africa since 1990 to date.
