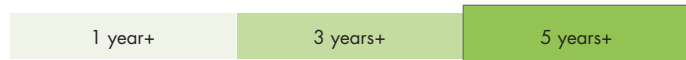

FUND OBJECTIVE

The fund aims to achieve long-term capital growth by primarily gaining exposure to the MSCI World ESG Leaders Index, a free float-adjusted market capitalisation weighted index designed to measure the equity market performance of companies with high Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) performance relative to their sector peers across developed markets worldwide.

WHO IS THIS FUND FOR?

This fund suits investors with a longer-term investment horizon who primarily seek capital growth through exposure to the developed market equities that make up the MSCI World ESG Leaders Index. These investors can tolerate stock market and currency volatility.

INVESTMENT MANDATE

Apart from assets in liquid form and exchange rate swaps, the fund only holds participatory interests in the Old Mutual MSCI World ESG Index Fund, a sub-fund of the Russell Investment Company Plc, which aims to replicate the performance of the MSCI World ESG Leaders Index. Derivatives can be used for efficient portfolio management purposes.

REGULATION 28 COMPLIANCE

The fund aims to offer exposure to a specific asset class. It holds a higher allocation to both international assets and equities than what is allowed in terms of Regulation 28 of the Pension Funds Act. This fund is therefore not Regulation 28 compliant.

INITIAL CHARGES (All fees are VAT inclusive)*:

There is no initial administration charge for investment transactions of R500 and above. Initial adviser fee will be between 0% and 3.45%.

Investment transactions below the R500 fund minimum incur a 2.30% administration charge.

* Please note: Initial charges do not apply to the Class B funds.

EXIT FEE:

Old Mutual Unit Trusts will charge an exit fee of 2.30% if exiting within 2 weeks of entry and reserves the right to charge this fee if exiting within 6 months of entry. The exit fee will not apply to investments in the fund via the Old Mutual Unit Trusts Tax-Free Investment.

Please note: The TERs are estimated. They do not have a full history of information and are negatively impacted by fixed costs at the inception of the fund. TER is a historic measure and clients are expected to experience a significantly lower fee going forward.

TER is a historic measure of the impact the deduction of management and operating costs has on a fund's value. A higher TER does not necessarily imply a poor return, nor does a low TER imply a good return. The current TER, which includes the annual service fee, may not necessarily be an accurate indication of future TERs. Transaction Cost (TC) is a necessary cost in administering the fund and impacts fund returns. It should not be considered in isolation as returns may be impacted by many other factors over time including market returns, the type of fund, the investment decisions of the investment manager and the TER. The TER and TC cannot be determined accurately for the funds that are less than one year old. Calculations are based on actual data where possible and best estimates where actual data is not available.

- Our cut-off time for client instructions (e.g. buying and selling) is at 15:00 each working day for all our funds, except the Money Market Funds, the price of which is set at 13:00. These are also the times we value our funds to determine the daily ruling price (other than at monthend when we value the Old Mutual Index Funds and Old Mutual Multi-Managers Fund of Funds range at 17:00 close). Daily prices are available on the public website and in the media.
- Unit trusts are traded at ruling prices, may borrow to fund client disinvestments and may engage in scrip lending. The daily ruling price is based on the current market value of the fund's assets plus income minus expenses (NAV of the portfolio) divided by the number of units on issue.
- The Net Asset Value to Net Asset Value figures are used for the performance calculations. The performance quoted is for a lump sum investment. The performance calculation includes income distributions prior to the deduction of taxes and distributions are reinvested on the ex-dividend date. Performances may differ as a result of actual initial fees, the actual investment date, the date of reinvestment and dividend withholding tax.
